A4.1 The notifiable diseases are:

- anthrax
- cholera
- diphtheria
- dysentery (amoebic or bacillary)
- acute encephalitis
- food poisoning
- leprosy
- leptospirosis
- malaria
- measles
- meningitis
- meningococcal septicaemia
- mumps
- ophthalmia neonatorum
- paratyphoid fever
- plague
- acute poliomyelitis
- rabies
- relapsing fever
- rubella
- scarlet fever
- smallpox
- tetanus
- tuberculosis
- typhoid fever
- viral haemorrhagic fever
- viral hepatitis (B,C)
- whooping cough
- yellow fever.

HIV is not on this list, but will be notified by the laboratory making the identification.
