Section A: Short Answer Questions (answer six from eight):

- 1. Write short notes on sclerosing odontogenic carcinoma.
- 2. Describe the histological manifestations of frictional and/or factitial hyperkeratoses of the oral mucosa.
- 3. What is "ISO 15189:2012 (Medical Laboratories)"?
- 4. Write short notes on:
 - a) sinonasal intestinal-type adenocarcinomab) respiratory epithelial adenomatoid hamartoma
- 5. Outline the histological features of amelogenesis imperfecta.
- 6. Write short notes on melanotic neuroectodermal tumour of infancy.
- 7. Write short notes on primordial odontogenic tumour.
- 8. What are the criteria for low and high grade dysplasia in laryngeal squamous epithelial precursor lesions?

Section B: Essays (answer two from three):

- 1. Describe the histopathology of chondroid and chondrogenic lesions of the tongue.
- 2. Write an essay on the (mammary analogue) secretory carcinoma of the salivary glands.
- 3. Discuss the differential diagnosis of verrucous carcinoma, papillary carcinoma and carcinoma cuniculatum of the oral cavity.
