Role description

The role holder will be asked to carry out the following on behalf of the specialty advisory committee:

- 1. Provide support and encouragement for veterinary pathologists wishing to take part in public engagement activities
- 2. Assist the College's Public Engagement Team to liaise with other organisations relevant to veterinary pathology
- 3. Help the College's Public Engagement Team coordinate requests for speakers and volunteers at public events
- 4. Promote RCPath educational resources available for download to other pathologists and scientists
- 5. Attend two meetings of the Veterinary Pathology specialty advisory committee in London each year and provide a report at those meetings.

Co-ordinators are <u>not</u> expected to organise all veterinary pathology events themselves.
