

Role description

The role holder will be asked to carry out the following on behalf of the specialty advisory committee:

1. Provide support and encouragement for veterinary pathologists wishing to take part in public engagement activities
2. Assist the College's Public Engagement Team to liaise with other organisations relevant to veterinary pathology
3. Help the College's Public Engagement Team coordinate requests for speakers and volunteers at public events
4. Promote RCPATH educational resources available for download to other pathologists and scientists
5. Attend two meetings of the Veterinary Pathology specialty advisory committee in London each year and provide a report at those meetings.

Co-ordinators are not expected to organise all veterinary pathology events themselves.
