- 1. A full description of the histological (and ultrastructural) appearances.
- 2. Your neuropathological diagnosis and, if indicated, the differential diagnoses.
- 3. The thinking behind (discussion) your diagnosis / diagnoses.
- 4. Any other investigations that you feel are NECESSARY to establish the diagnosis or assist with patient management.
