

## CHANGES TO THE FRCPATH PART 1 CLINICAL BIOCHEMISTRY EXAMINATION

The Royal College of Pathologists will introduce a new format for the FRCPath Part 1 Clinical Biochemistry examination from Autumn 2018.

The examination will be blueprinted to the current (i.e. 2010) Chemical Pathology curriculum. Approximately 25% of questions in any one examination will be knowledge based and 75% will concern the application of knowledge.

The new examination will comprise a single paper of 125 multiple choice questions (MCQs) in single best answer format.

The pass mark for the paper will be set by an objective procedure by an independentlychaired standard setting group where individual questions are reviewed to create a minimum standard using a modified Angoff process.

Sample MCQs will appear on this website shortly. The current format of the FRCPath Part 1 Clinical Biochemistry examination (comprising essays and short answer questions) will be held for the last time in Spring 2018.
