Reporting to Reception

Site Awareness

Fire Safety

How to Find Us

1. Join the Coryton Roundabout

Pass the Whitchurch turning heading towards M4 Westbound. Follow signs toward Superstore and Forest Farm.



2. Exit and approach roundabout

Follow lane markings and signage for Forest Farm. You will need to take the straight-ahead lane, taking the second exit off the roundabout.



3. Continue along main road

Drive along the tree-lined road (Longwood Drive).



4. Turn at Cytiva / WGHC signage

Turn left at the blue Wales Genomic Health Centre sign.



5. Enter site (10mph) taking the right-hand lane to stop at the gatehouse.

Inform security that you are attending the Wales Genomic Health Centre. You will be directed to the visitor car park located to the right of the entrance. Observe speed limits and follow arrows.



6. Proceed to car park

Follow signs for visitor parking and reception.



Getting to the Reception

1. Proceeding from the carpark on foot

Use pedestrian pathways and follow signage to the main entrance. If you are unable to take the steps, there is a ramp available for accessibility.



2. Follow the path to the centre

Walk along the walkway towards the Wales Genomic Health Centre entrance.



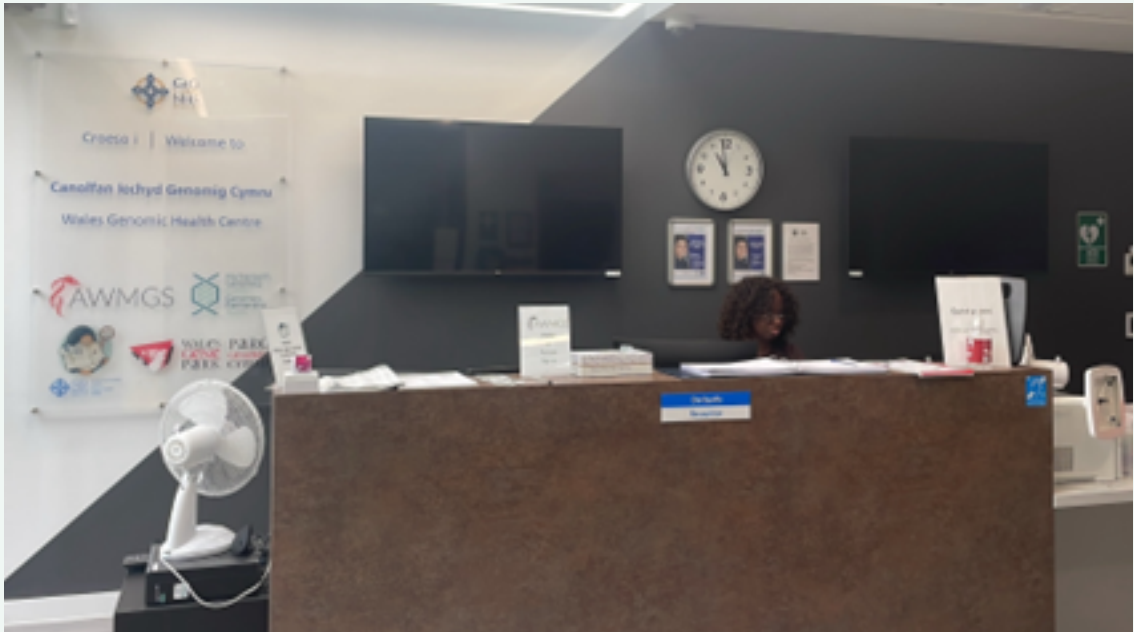
3. Cross the Road using the crossing

Proceed to cross the pedestrian crossing at the bottom of the ramp and head down the path leading to the Genomics Centre (located to the right as you walk).



4. Report to Reception

There is a door entry buzzer located to the right of the doors- buzz the main reception button to gain entry to the facility. Report to the main reception desk where you will be met by the reception team.
