Section A: Short Answer Questions (answer six from eight):

- 1. Write short notes on myoepithelial tumours of soft tissue and bone.
- 2. Discuss the handling of lymph node biopsies in the histopathology laboratory.
- 3. Using direct immunofluorescence, which criteria distinguish the autoimmune mucocutaneous vesiculobullous diseases?
- 4. Write short notes on:
 - a) SOX-10
 - b) brachyury
- 5. Outline the histological, immunohistochemical and molecular diagnosis of nodular fasciitis.
- 6. Discuss the diagnostic histopathological applications of antibodies to cytokeratins 7 and 20.
- 7. Write short notes on:
 - a) mechanisms of fungal pathogenesis
 - b) "mitosoid bodies"
- 8. Write short notes on tumour-infiltrating lymphocytes.

Section B: Essays (answer two from three):

- 1. What is the histological differential diagnosis of a spindle cell neoplasm of the skin of the scalp? Outline how you would establish a definitive diagnosis.
- 2. Describe the clinicopathological varieties of osteosarcoma.
- 3. Discuss the role of Epstein-Barr virus in disease.
