Section A: Short Answer Questions (answer six from eight):

1. Write short notes on sclerosing odontogenic carcinoma.
2. Describe the histological manifestations of frictional and/or factitial hyperkeratoses of the oral mucosa.
3. What is “ISO 15189:2012 (Medical Laboratories)”?
4. Write short notes on:
 - a) sinonasal intestinal-type adenocarcinoma
 - b) respiratory epithelial adenomatoid hamartoma
5. Outline the histological features of amelogenesis imperfecta.
6. Write short notes on melanotic neuroectodermal tumour of infancy.
7. Write short notes on primordial odontogenic tumour.
8. What are the criteria for low and high grade dysplasia in laryngeal squamous epithelial precursor lesions?

Section B: Essays (answer two from three):

1. Describe the histopathology of chondroid and chondrogenic lesions of the tongue.
2. Write an essay on the (mammary analogue) secretory carcinoma of the salivary glands.
3. Discuss the differential diagnosis of verrucous carcinoma, papillary carcinoma and carcinoma cuniculatum of the oral cavity.
